## Rebalancing Justice - Time, Times and Half a Time

The right to administer justice is given and taken away by God. The Jubilee year acts as both an indication of God's favour but also the expectation for freedom to passed on, to forgive as you have been forgiven. Otherwise there would be consequences. Where God's people have been unjustly treated God would step in and rescue them and where God's people unjustly treat others God would step in and punish them. Such times are brought to a culmination of a 'time, times and half a time' (in the Book of Daniel and expanded in the Book of Revelation). As such it best seen as rebalancing human justice.


Here it is illustrated in the 'sevens' (which Daniel 9 reveals) that are repeated throughout the years. Notice how the Jubilee Year counted every 50th year comes and goes, because the heavenly cycleis based on a continuous counting of 'sevens'. Yet when Jesus ministers there is not only a Jubilee Year, but also a 777 year (in sync with the 'sevens'), he is the Lord of the Sabbath after all. Jesus establishes justice once and for all. Keeping in step with the Father's timetable - his ministry covers and highlights the period of a 'time, times and half a time'.


The Jubilees can be seen as an agreed year when an intercalation as needed to rebalance justice here on earth. And the 'time, times and half a time' for God's people can be seen to be similar to God's measuring of the Babylonian Empire in the phrase 'Mene, mene, tekel, parsin'. "Here is what these words mean: Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end. Tekel You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting. Peres:


Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians." Daniel 5:30

The 'time, times and half a time' has significant correlations for us, in relation to 1260 years in the book of Revelation that precedes the unprecedented period of Christ's reign, in the Tribulation before Christ's Second Coming and in the tracking of events during Esther's reign.
